We're all in this together

Five Community Service Centres across the Gold Coast provide crisis relief through the provision of food vouchers, clothing, accommodation vouchers and assistance with bills / utilities.

Fairhaven at Tambourine is a rehabilitation service for people with drug, alcohol and gambling addictions. More than 50 people participate in the program at any one time. Fairhaven Street level is located at Southport and facilitates between Tambourine and the Gold Coast providing face to face assistance to those experiencing addiction at community level.

Salvation Army Chaplains play a special role in the community. We currently have a court chaplain at the Southport court as well as a prison chaplain who visits Numinbah Prison.

At Salvo Care Line, trained counsellors – many of them volunteers – offer telephone counselling 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, for people experiencing a crisis or difficulties. A number of the telephone counsellors are based on the Gold Coast. Ph: 1300 36 36 22.

Stillwaters, Crisis accommodation available for 20 women (over 18 years) and 7 women with children (up to 12 years). Clients are assisted through programs such as parenting, life skills and self-esteem. They are also externally supported with re-settlement into the community and by referral to other services.

Money Care services are a new initiative established by The Salvation Army after a need was identified in the community. Assessing and acting as an advocate to financial institutions, qualified financial advisors assess individual's circumstances and provide a plan to reduce, manage and finalise outstanding debt.

Family Tracing Service

This wonderful service exists to re-connect families after they have been separated. The service now successfully helps around 2,000 people each year.
